



As instrument flying actually functions, the pilot often has a much more accurate knowledge of his location when on instruments than when he is in visual contact with the ground. Consequently, the results are just opposite of "blind." The difficult technical side of instrument flying is taken care of on a radio directive device which is used to transmit an electrical signal in certain areas and the work of the pilot is only to pick up the signal and recognize it. From his ability to recognize the signal he knows his exact position. Experiments have been made repeatedly whereby planes are brought in and landed with the pilot under cover, and he never sees the ground until the landing operation has taken

The rapid development of the radio and electrical industry generally have made this type of flying safe and desirable. They have con-tributed materially to the advance-ment of aviation both in commercial and private flying. Many of the developments have been applied and developed during the present period of hostilities.
