Ordinance No. 71

An ordinance to prohibit the building of any frame building on lots 1-2-3-4-5-6-7-8 in block 68, and lots 9-10-11-12-13-14-15-16, block 69, in the village of Nemaha City, Nebraska, and providing a penalty for the violation of the provisions of this ordinance.

Be it ordained by the chairman and board of trustees of the village of Nemaha City, Nebraska:

Section 1—That from and after the passage and publication of this ordinance it shall be unlawful for any person to build any frame building on lots 1-2-3-4-5-6-7-8, in block 68, and 9-10-11-12-13-14-15-16 in block 69, in the village of Nemaha City, Nebraska. Provided, That said board of trustees shall have power to grant permission to build such buildings under such safeguards as they may deem necessary.

Sec. 2—That any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be liable to a fine of not less than \$100 nor to exceed \$500 and shall be compelled to remove such building or veneer it with brick or steel at the option of the board of trustees.

Sec. 3—Any person so fined shall stand committed until said fine and costs of prosecution are paid.

Adopted this 5th day of February, A. D. 1906.
