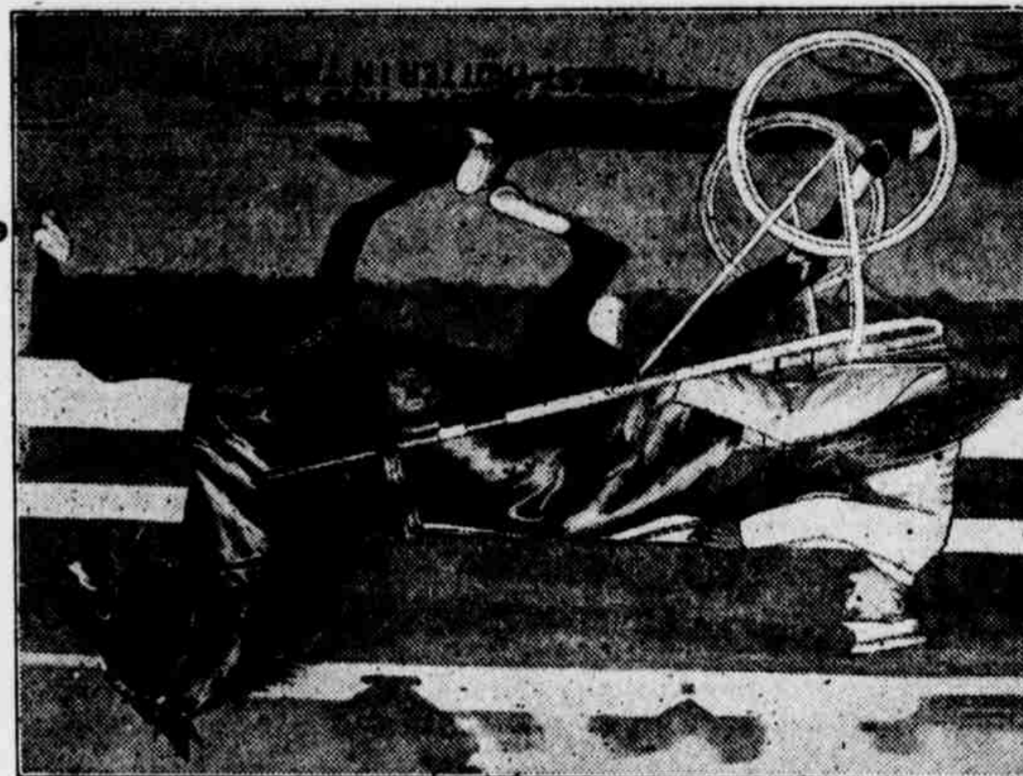

SYMPTOMS OF WORMS The coat becomes rough; there is a dry hacking cough; the appetite is irregular; sometimes poor, other times craving; the bowels sometimes loose, other times constipated.
