## Nebraska to be Out of Debt

Lincoln, Sept. 18.-For the first time in many years Nebraska will be out of debt, at the end of the present biennium.

The grand assessment roll, just completed, shows taxable wealth of the value of \$329,000,-

This will produce in taxes for the next two years \$4,967,000, or about \$500,000 more than the appropriations of the last legislature.

In addition, the state will receive in fees and government aid to schools and universities \$600,-000 more. This will enable the state to pay off every outstanding warrant and have money left.

Ten years ago the state was \$2,000,000 to the bad, and almost every fund, save the permanent school, was behind.

Persistent economy, coupled with the opportunity through prosperity, to levy a small additional tax each year, solved the financial difficulty.
