




DESIGN FOR CEMENT STUCCO.

FIRST FLOOR PLAN.

This design has a dark red brick running to the window sills. Balance is pure white cement stucco work, with half timber in the dormer and gable of the front plazza. Living room has a fireplace, beamed ceiling and open stairway. Dining room connected with the living room through pedestaled archway and has built out buffet with high windows above. Den connected with dining room by French doors. Three chambers, large closets, sleeping porch, open balcony and bathroom in second story. Finish for the first story in all rooms except the kitchen to be clear red oak. Balance in birch, natural, with clear birch floors. Size 26 feet wide by 36 feet deep over the main part. First story 9 feet. Second story 8 feet. Basement 7 feet. Cost to build, exclusive of heating and plumbing. about \$4.500.
