An offer of a thousand pounds a year, with free food and lodging and plenty of adventure thrown in, is going begging because England has no modern Jonah who knows whales intimately.


Last month the colonial office in London advertised for a "director of research" to take charge of a scientific expedition that is scheduled to start next spring for the Falkland Islands to study aquatic mammals and their habits. So far not a suitable application has been received.

The purpose of the expedition is to obtain data from which to frame legislation to prevent the disappearance of whales. The scientists will endeavor to learn whether they are polygamous, how long they live, where they spend the winter and what their annual mileage is.
