The new instantaneous fuse is set off by a blasting cap, so that its entire length explodes at once. Fiftypound boxes of 20 per cent dynamite will be placed at 20-foot intervals in one of the worst drift locations along the road. Each box will be opened and the Cordeau fuse strung between them, after which they will be sealed. This powder will be left beneath snowdrifts during the winter, and next spring a blasting cap will be inserted in the end of the fuse and the entire charge detonated at once.

London.-A collection of Saxon coins issued during the reigns of five Wessex kings has been discovered in a cave near Peakiand, Derbyshire, by Rev. G. H. Wilson. Human and animal remains found in the outer chambers of the cave indicate, according to antiquarians, the cave was formerly the dwelling place of a personage, pos-sibly of a Mercian ruler of than a thousand years


