NEW YORK. (ANP)—The formation of the Pan African society was announced last week by W. Emlen Roosevelt, grand-nephew of Theodore Roosevelt. Mr. Roosevelt serves as president of the new society.

The society's purpose is to aid in the development of cultural, economic and political relations between the United States and the various Governments of Africa. News letters dealing with African affairs will be published by the organization.

It is said in some corners that the group is primarily interested in encouraging close relations with the Union of South Africa (the Jim Crow haven of Africa). The membership roster for the group is made up of representatives of large capital interests.

NEW YORK. (ANP)—Ceremonies were held last week to mark the establishment of the new Harlem Welfare center.

The center will be the first which the city has built for its welfare department. Total cost of the five story building on which construction is to start this fall is estimated at \$1,718,000. The center will contain space for all functions of the department.

Mayor O'Dwyer, featured speaker on the program, outlined a plan of construction work for Harlem in the next four years that will have a total cost of more than \$200,000,000.
