Figs Come, Flying. Welcome, Prize Fighters. Mixed News. Wheat Again. By ARTHUR BRISBANE

From N. H. Sloane, general manager of the California Development association, this writer received on Thursday a letter by flying machine, and with a box of ripe California figs, picked in California at 5 Tuesday afternoon. Mr. Sloane says: "Mayor Hyman now here says figs have not been delivered in perfect condition in New York. California will develop the great commercial flying machine by its endeavor to put ripe and perishable fruit upon the tables of New York."

That's progress. But that's only a small part of it. Flying machines will bring perishable ripe fruits from California and Florida to those that can afford them. And, infinitely more important, flying machines will carry inhabitants in a few hours from all other parts of the United States to California, to Florida and to all the places that Americans ought to see.

Twenty women are hurt in a bargain ruin, trying to buy brooms for 1 cent apiece.

In Chile, an archaeologist discovers a mummy, one of the royal Incas, 2,000 years old. It wore false hair.

High Commissioner Samuel of Palestine reports excellent progress in the rebuilding of the Jewish state. An American has just gone over to start a life insurance company. What part of all that is news?

Russian reports show a shortage in the grain crop of 150,000,000 pounds, nearly 3,000,000 tons of grain. The bolshevik government will spend fifteen millions to buy seed for farmers, other millions to feed the hungry.

As far away as Russia, nature seems to be waiting to help Coolidge by putting up the price of grain. In Chicago yesterday wheat and other grains again went up. If that continues it will be hard for the farmer to keep his mind on his troubles.

Ogden L. Mills, prosperous youth, campaigning for Coolidge, will ask this political question every day: "Why turn them over?"

He will ask them how they expect to do any better getting rid of Coolidge and taking in Davis. Mr. Mills should remember the flitterate Greek citizen voting to banish Aristides "Because I am tired of hearing him called 'The Just.'"

Many voters vote for a change just for the sake of a change. Our friends in Paris say "they suspect" that Secretary Hughes is in London "in the interest of American bankers." How suspicious those Frenchmen are. Soon they will be suggesting that Thomas Lamont of Morgan & Co. is in London also in the interest of American bankers.

The Salvation Army prison department requested from charitable ladies hats in good condition, not more than six weeks old, or money to buy new hats—for young women coming out of prison. It seems—please don't laugh—that if a woman comes out of jail with a hat more than three months old it hurts her pride and "makes it difficult for her to re-establish her self-respect."

On Thursday night Georges Carpentier endured desperate punishment without flinching. Americans of the 100 per cent red-blooded, he-man Nordic type, sometimes underestimate the courage of Frenchmen and other Latins. They will learn something from Carpentier's willingness to take cruel punishment. And Carpentier wasn't teaching boxing in camp 3,000 miles from the war. ## U.S. Would Make Vassal of Europe, Communists Say

### American Capital Dictating to Allies at Conference, Reds Declare—"On With Proletarian Revolution."

Moscow, July 27.—In the course of a long, severely critical and flamboyant pronouncement touching on the anniversary of the outbreak of the world war and the conference in London, the executive committee of the communist international says that all the countries represented at the conference expect salvation through intervention of the United States.

"But," the statement adds, "the United States itself is beset with an agrarian crisis, 2,000,000 farmers throwing away their plots of ground and the shadow of economic catastrophe is knocking at its door."

"America's internal market is being curtailed more and more. Ruined and exhausted, Europe cannot absorb America's goods while in Europe, America, the United States is finding an increasingly narrow scope for its capital. Mr. Morgan is dictating to the United States and in the name of the United States, General Dawes and Secretary Hughes are dictating to Europe."

"U. S. Most Avaricious." "One of the first results of a democratic pacifist era will be the coming of a dictatorship of American capital, which aims to transform Europe into a vassal colony."

"The English labor government and the left bloc in France are serving as a curtain for this dictatorship."

"After four years of fruitless wrangling on the reparations problem, the United States, the most terrible and avaricious participant in the war, enters the European arena ready with its European allies to strangle the German proletariat and transform Germany into an international colony for the machinations and exploitations of the robbers of all countries."

"On With Revolution." "The results of the present London conference will bring to the German workers a 12-hour day, dismissal of 10 per cent of the railway workers, curtailment of the state employees, imposition of heavy taxes, increased customs and railroad tariffs and high prices. German workers will be converted into slaves of democracy and coolies of pacifism."

"The executive committee urges the proletariat and the toilers of the world not to allow a repetition of the world war and concludes its manifesto with the following words: "Hands off the German proletariat! Down with imperialist slavery in the guise of pacifism! Down with the dictatorship of Morgan and American capital! Down with the Versailles treaty and the second international and forward toward the proletarian revolution!"
