

WOMAN AND BABY ATTACKED BY COW

Misfortune of Family Is Doubled When Fire Destroys Their Barn.

Special Dispatch to The Omaha Bee. Geneva, Neb., July 31.—Mrs. Clyde Michaels, wife of a young farmer living in Chelsea township, was badly injured by being attacked by a cow Monday evening and within two hours afterward the barn, one of the best in Fillmore county, was burned.

Mrs. Michaels, with a 2-year-old child in her arms, was helping drive the cattle in from the pasture when the Red Poll cow with a calf by its side suddenly knocked her down and tramped upon her until her husband prodded the animal with a pitchfork and released the victim.

Ten stitches were required to close the gash cut in Mrs. Michaels' face; her nose was painfully hurt and her body bruised. The baby, underneath the recumbent form of the mother, escaped injury.

Spontaneous combustion is supposed to have started the fire which destroyed the barn, valued at \$4,000, and contents, estimated to be worth \$600. Two horses in the barn were rescued, but a buggy, wagon, plow, harness and farm machinery were burned. Insurance carried on the building was \$1,200.

Lightning Strikes House.

Columbus, Neb., July 31.—Mr. and Mrs. John Kuhn and their three children, tenants of a farm near Columbus, lost all their clothing except that which they were wearing at the time when fire destroyed their home and all its contents last night.

Neighbors who first saw the flames sounded a general alarm over the party phone line, formed a bucket brigade and saved other buildings. The fact that Mr. and Mrs. Kuhn had left no fire in any stove in the house gave rise to the theory that lightning had struck the house.

Horses Kill Farm Hand.

Beatrice, Neb., July 31.—Harold Ray, 19, farm hand employed at the Charles Lewis place south of the city, died last night at a hospital here from injuries received when he was trampled by a team of horses, which he attempted to harness when they tried to run away from a threshing machine.
