the clearances of wheat from North America during September will be very heavy.

The wheat market may or may not be in debatable ground. Without steady export absorption it is highly questionable as to whether speculators will continue to support the market, especially on the advances, with hedging sales so large. The movement of winter wheat continues large, and the spring wheat run is just around the corner.

There seems to be every reason to look for an early and heavy run of wheat from the American northwest when threshed. The movement from Canada is also likely to be liberal. There apparently has been considerable new trop Canadian wheat worked for shipment during the next few months. At least there are claims to that effect. Cash wheat at Winnipeg today was strong.

Wheat and flour on ocean supply for the week decreased \$,218,000 bushels. The total supply is 34,320,000 bushels, against 35,464,000 bushels a year say. It is quite true that the world shipments have fallen the last few weeks, and in a measure this may account for the reduction of supplies on ocean passage, but nevertheless Europe is absorbing the grain headed that way, and will need much more wheat this year than last. Cables from Liverpool had it that weather conditions were unfavorable for harvesting in the United Kingdom and France.
