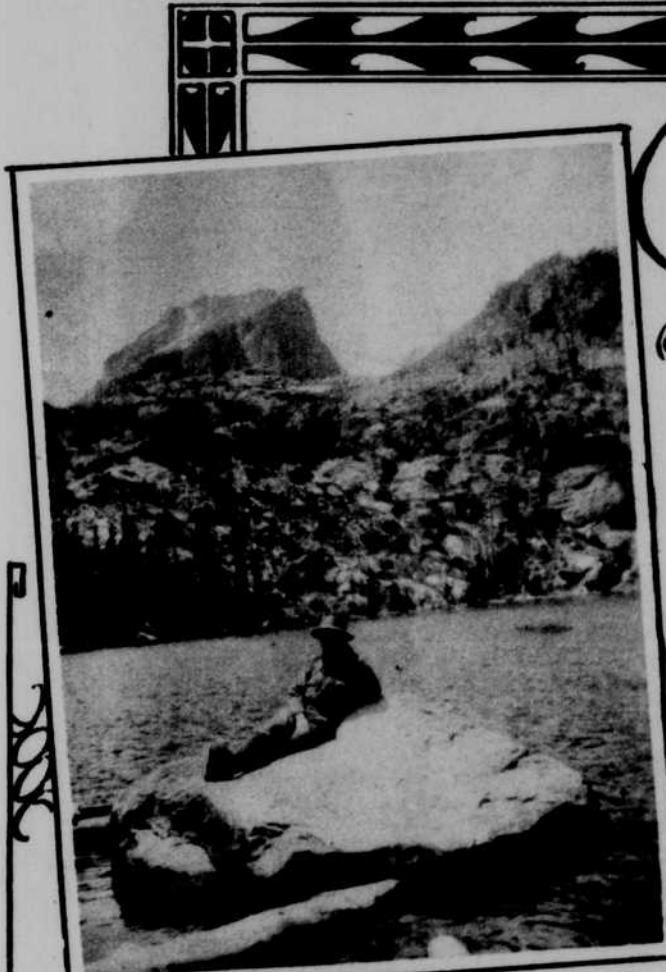


GREAT WHITE WAY AT SEA. Searchlights of the British grand fleet making a shining path across the sky in a recent review. P. & A. photo.

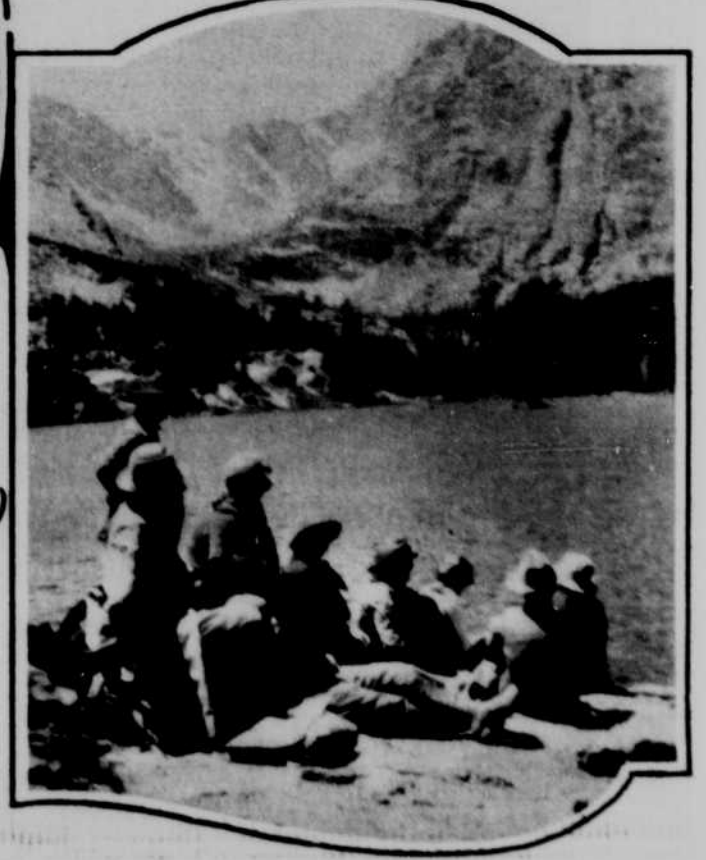
