Betting, Not Investing. Who Made the Devil? A Mind Test. Education in Pictures.

When you buy European bonds you bet your money, in return for a high interest rate, that the nation in which you invest will remain at peace, won't become bankrupt through another war, or repudiate its bonds as Russia did flatly, or as Germany did with equal effect by making her currency worthless.

For safety invest in the United States. The Rev. Mr. Potter of the Unitarian church asks "Who made the devil?" And says that question is Christianity's great stumbling block. "In the early Apostolic church and in the dark ages," says he, "the devil was as important to theology as God Himself."

In the first chapter of Job you are told: "The sons of God came to present themselves before the Lord, and Satan came also among them." If God created everything, he must have created the devil also. But shall presumptuous men dare to ask why that devil was created?

Such questions land you in the ranks of Ingersollism. The Rev. Mr. Potter may find himself wondering with Ingersoll why Divine wisdom, foreseeing everything, did not, right at the start, drown the serpent and thus avoid the fall and the necessity of drowning all of the human race. The fewer questions we ask, the deeper our faith.

Here's one test of mind power applied to a young murderer in prison. He was told: "Two men had just come down a chimney. The face of one was clean, the other face was black with soot. The man with a clean face immediately washed his face. The man with the sooty face did not wash his face. Why?"

The young murderer "tested" gave the right answer immediately. Many average minds won't give it. The answer is that the clean face man, seeing the other dirty, thought his face must be dirty and washed it. The man with the sooty face seeing the other clean, thought his face was clean also, and therefore did not wash. Three out of 10 at least will not answer instantly. Try it on your friends.

was ever done by Pestalozzi, Froebel and Rousseau's "Emile" combined. Prof. Fritz Haber says a future super-race will live a thousand years. Chemicals will destroy diseases, hold back old age, and in years to come, if you return then you will live longer than Methuselah.

Can you imagine any worse news? If men lived 1,000 years, with the earth fully populated as it soon would be, each couple could have only two children, in a thousand years. That would be birth control on a scale not hitherto planned. And it would deprive the human race of its greatest pleasure and inspiration—the care and study of young children.

Imagine a couple aged 1,000 years, with a daughter 950 years old and a son 948 years old? Rather a dreary household. Nature is kind in letting us die young, so that we can have plenty of children and enjoy them, and, perhaps, come back soon and have plenty more—without overcrowding.
