

Plan to Dredge Carter Lake

Hummel Outlines Improvement Program at Meet With Engineers' Committee.

A new program for the development of Carter lake and park is being considered by City Commissioner J. B. Hummel, with the aid and counsel of the public improvements department and a committee representing the Engineers' club of Omaha.

A conference was held Thursday afternoon in Mr. Hummel's office, attended by Commissioner Joseph Koutsky, City Engineer Herman Beal, and R. H. Findley and J. A. Bruce, representing the Engineers' club.

Commissioner Hummel will recommend to the city council next Tuesday that the Schneider electrical works of this city be engaged to prepare plans and specifications for a new suction dredge, this preliminary work to cost \$1,200. The proposition of the Schneiders, that they supervise construction of the new dredge on a basis of 5 per cent, is being held in abeyance. The Schneider company recently submitted to the

city an estimate of \$46,000 as the cost of a new dredge, including one and one-half miles of pontoons and piping, and using the pump and cutter in the old dredge now at the lake.

Mr. Hummel stated that it is proposed to operate the new dredge with electricity instead of with steam which was used in the old dredge.

The city owns 239 acres of land and water at Carter lake. Dredging was done at the lake from 1912 to 1916 on the west and north sides of the lake. The east end is nearly filled with silt and vegetation. The dredging already done resulted in covering about 90 acres of the land area with an average of 4½ feet of new soil.

Since the dredging was stopped nearly four feet of silt has formed on the bottom of the lake. Engineers
