

### Dad-Lad Week Festivities to Begin Sunday

#### Church Services and Numerous Banquets Are Planned for Local Observance.

Tens of thousands of fathers and sons will attend the opening services of National Father and Son week Sunday in churches throughout the United States, according to J. H. Beveridge, general chairman of the Omaha father and son committee. Mr. Beveridge will open the local Father and Son week officially from radio station WQAW Sunday morning at 9:30; Sunday night at 6:55 eastern time. Walter W. Head will speak to the whole nation from radio station WJZ at New York city.

Following Mr. Beveridge's opening address, Omaha churches will unite with those of the entire country in observing Father and Son week Sunday by holding services with special music and sermons for fathers and sons.

#### Special Church Services.

Among the many churches that will hold special father and son services are: Central Park Congregational, First Central Congregational, First Reformed, First Christian, Miller Park Presbyterian, Benson Methodist, First Methodist, Clifton Hill Presbyterian, Pleasant Green Baptist, Westminster Presbyterian, Trinity Baptist, Bohany Presbyterian Chapel, Parkvale Presbyterian, Trinity Methodist, South Side Christian, St. Cecilia's cathedral. Several other churches will hold special father and son services on next Sunday morning at the close of the Father and Son week of the period.

A series of banquets will begin on Monday night and will continue for two weeks. On Monday evening the Kountze Memorial Lutheran church will hold its banquet with 300 fathers and sons attending. Gilbert H. Gendall, Omaha boy scout executive, will be the principal speaker. Midland college will furnish a boy speaker and special musical numbers.

#### Dad-Lad Banquets.

The Benson Parent-Teachers' association will also hold a father and son meeting Monday night at the school, with Chester G. Linn, dean of boys at Technical High school, as the main speaker. H. L. Colson, president of the Parent-Teachers' association, will be in charge. At Garfield school a father and son meeting will be held Monday night at 8. E. R. Knight, president of the Parent-Teachers' association, will preside, and Judge L. B. Day will speak. Rev. Barton Johnson will lead the singing of father and son songs.

J. H. Beveridge, general chairman of the father and son committee, will be the speaker at Miller Park Presbyterian church Monday night. On Tuesday night the Dundee Presbyterian church will hold its banquet, with Dwight E. Porter, principal of Technical High school, as speaker. On the same night will be the banquet at Westminster Presbyterian church. Dr. L. C. Denise will be the main speaker at the Central Park Congregational church the same evening.

St. Cecilia cathedral will banquet its fathers and sons at the Brandeis restaurants on Tuesday night, with Archbishop J. J. Hartz as the principal speaker.

#### Well-Known Speakers.

Wednesday evening will see several more banquets, among them the Clifton Hill Presbyterian church, where Judge C. O. Stauffer will speak; the Trinity Methodist church, where Rev. F. K. Hargrove will be the main speaker; Our Saviour Lutheran church, where Rev. O. E. Edlight will give the main address; Loyd Avenue Presbyterian church, with Dean Irving S. Cutter as principal speaker, and Temple Israel.

The largest father and son banquet ever held in Omaha will be put on at Technical High school Tuesday evening. J. R. Perkins of Council Bluffs will be the speaker. The First Methodist church also will hold their banquet on Thursday with 400 in attendance expected. Dr. J. P. Lord is to speak. The South Side Christian church will banquet on the same evening as will also Trinity Methodist church and the Benson Methodist church, where Rev. C. C. Cissell will be the principal speaker.

Friday night probably will be the busiest night of the week for banquets, the largest of which will be at the First Central Congregational church, where 400 men and boys are expected. President Frank E. Mossman of Morningside college will be the speaker and several unique entertainment features are being planned by the committee of which Dr. O. A. Runyan is chairman. The First Reformed church will banquet its fathers and sons on Friday night, with Dr. R. R. Bryan as speaker, and the First Christian church will have former Pastor Dr. Charles E. Cobey, now president of Cotner university, as its speaker on Friday evening.

#### Radio Talks Broadcast.

The Dietz Memorial Methodist church will banquet on Friday night as will the Walnut Hill Methodist church. E. E. McMillan, principal of North High school, will speak at the banquet at Parkvale Presbyterian church and Hon. L. C. Oberlies of Lincoln will be the speaker at the Papillion Methodist church on Friday night. Irving Stalmaster will speak at the father and son banquet at Pleasant Green Baptist church the same evening.

Radio talks every night of father and son week, except Wednesday night, also will feature the week's activities. On Monday night O. Lawrence Hawthorne will read some of his father and son poems over the radio at 9:30. On Tuesday night B. A. Wilcox of the Omaha National bank will take the air for a father and son message. Thursday night Dr. Frank G. Smith will be the radio father and son speaker, and on Friday night Principal Dwight E. Porter

### CITY MUST PAY FIREMAN \$7,000

Albion, Neb., Nov. 7.—The case of Jim Thompson against the city of Albion for \$7,000 damages was tried in district court and a verdict returned giving him \$7,000.

Thompson was a volunteer fireman two years ago, when the door of the fire house crushed his foot as he was going to a fire. The wound became infected and it was necessary to amputate his foot.

The plaintiff claimed the city had been negligent in not keeping the door in good condition. The city has already paid Thompson over \$5,000 for doctors, nursing and hospital expenses.
