Columbus, Neb. Nov. 8 .- Platte ounty, usually a democratic strong-old, went into the La Follette-forpresident column by a margin of 403 dtes; gave United States Senator Norris, republican, a majority of 801, out turned about and gave Congress man Howard a lead of 3,743 and aller majorities to Norton ther democrats on the state and gislative tickets.

The official canvass, completed toy, shows Platte county gave La collette 2,576 votes over John Davis, who polled 2,173, and who, in turn. led Calvin Coolidge by 65, the latter's total being 2.108.

While giving Senator Norris a ma ority of 801, Platte county voters rejected the constitutional amendnt which he endorsed.




