The annual writing contest for the Omaha Women's Press club will close Saturday, November 15. This is the fourth contest held by the club.

There are four classes, the short story for which there is a prize of \$50, the one-act play, \$25, the 24-line poem, \$25 and 1,500 words miscellaneous prose, \$25.

Authors who submit to the contest may retain all rights to the manuscripts and may at the same time submit to publishers and producers.

The manuscripts will be given to the judges upon the close of the contest and the awards will be announced at the annual dinner of the Omaha Women's Press club, which will be held early in January.

Competent judges chosen by the club for the one-act play are Miss Lena May Williams of Central High school, Miss Lillian Fitch of the Ann Morgan Studios of Chicago and Charles R. Docherty.

For the short story, poem and 1,500-word miscellaneous the judges are Mrs. Anna Steese Richardson, associate editor of the Woman's Home companion, Dr. Ralph E. B. Wiley of the First Unitarian church and W. R. Watson, managing editor of the World-Herald.
