Banquet Given for Retiring Burlington Trainmaster and Examiner.

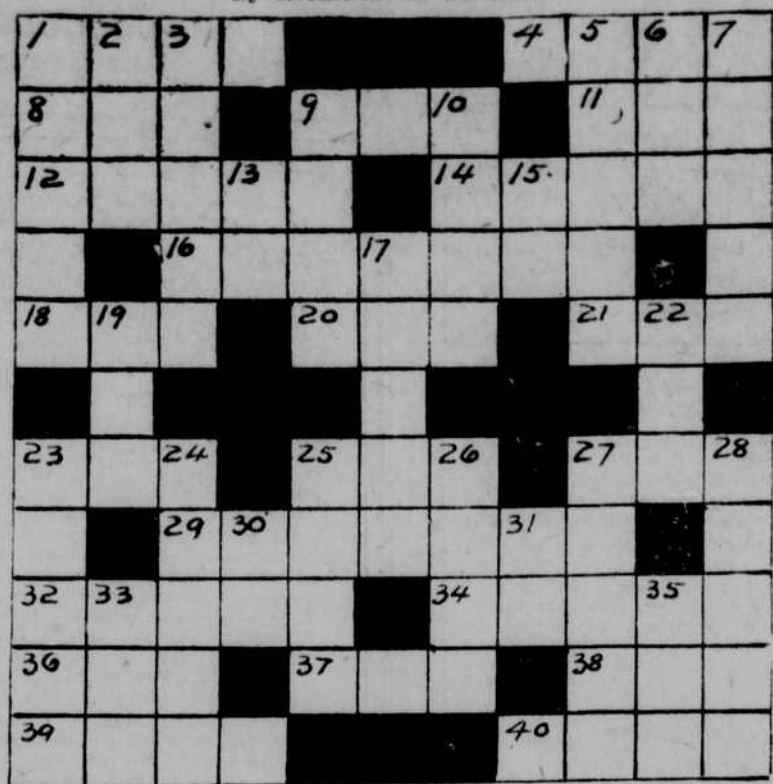
Wymore, Jan. 30.—At a meeting and banquet here, 61 fellow members of the Masonic lodge tendered a farewell to C. P. Philbrick, retiring train master and train rules examiner of the Burlington railway, a railway employe for 53 years, and resident of Wymore for the last 26 years. Mr. Philbrick became a member of the Mohican (Kan.) lodge 50 years ago, and has been affiliated with the Wymore lodge for the last 26 years, and it was found that in the number present at the banquet, only two were members at the time Mr. Philbrick came here. Toasts and responses were made by several of the members.

Mr. Philbrick is one of the Burlington railroad men and had much to do with the development and building of the lines west of the Missouri River, and with the shaping of the career of hundreds of railway and professional men at their start in the various walks of life, and is widely known all over the Burlington system, having traveled to every division for many years as rules examiner.

He retired on account of the age limit in the last year, and has arranged to go to Downey, in southern California, where, with relatives, and friends, he will make his future home. He spent a part of the winter on the coast, and is back in Wymore to complete arrangement of personal affairs. He will leave this week for his new home.
