

BASS BITING WELL AT STATE LAKES

Best Catches Reported at Night With White Bait.

Rains of the last week or so have made traveling difficult in the lake regions of north Nebraska...

The best catches of big bass now are being made after sundown and as late as 11 p. m. with the white artificial bait...

Jack West of Woodlake declares that the luminous baits are the best just now, while other enthusiasts insist that any white bait will do the work while the moon is out.

Daylight fishing also is good, and no trouble is experienced in catching the limit, either with plugs or frogs, which are fairly abundant.

Some of the largest strings and biggest bass the last week are reported from Rat and Beaver lakes, 40 miles south and west of Woodlake and Johnston. These lakes are considered two of the best bass lakes in Cherry county or any other part of north Nebraska...

MOUNTAIN JOYS AT ESTES PARK

That the Estes park region was early recognized as an outing place of more than ordinary pretensions and of unusual charm is attested by the fact that the first visitors, who came in 1865, were on recreation and pleasure bent.

The park was named for Joel Estes, who settled in the locality during the early 40s.

This section was well and favorably known as Estes park until the founding of Rocky Mountain National park—so named because it represents the typical scenery of the higher Rocky mountains, including, as it does, some 30 miles of the guardian peaks which here make up the continental divide—the backbone of America—in 1915.
