Meridian Bridge Near Completion

St. Helena, Neb., June 27.—According to a statement made by E. V. Kelly, secretary of the Kelly-Atkinson company, which has the contract for the steel work of the Meridian highway bridge across the Missouri river just north of here, all the steel for the bridge, down to the last piece

will be in place and riveted and the steel contractors will be off the job by July 15.

Meanwhile concrete work for the Dakota approach is moving forward rapidly and, according to the construction company, should be completed by the last of July.

It is expected that the bridge which fills the gap in the Meridian highway between Nebraska and South Dakota will be completed so that it can be used by tourists and for traffic in general next fall.
