Annual City Net Meet to Be Held in Middle of July

Municipal Tennis Association, City Park Commissioners to Decide on Centralized Court.

After rather uncertain play on Omaha tennis courts for several weeks due to rainy weather, "Old Sol" seems to have retailed, and his shiny face has put the courts in good condition.

In the light of this, tennis players of the city are planning tournaments and extensive improvements for the month of July.

Next in importance will be the meeting Tuesday afternoon of the Municipal Tennis Association with the city commissioners to determine a site for the new proposed centralized tennis courts.

The Men's Service League, a very strong civic organization, is backing the association to a man.

N. K. Harman, secretary of the association, says there has been some difference of opinion as to just what will constitute a centralized court, and offers the following plan:

"We propose to build one centralized court in the center of the town, and keep the other courts in the parks. We could stage elimination tournaments on the courts at the parks, and hold the final matches at the centralized court."

Next in importance will be the annual city tennis tournament to be held on the Field club court starting July 15.

At that time the best players in the city will compete for city honors, Ralph Powell, state champion; David Davis, city champion; E. R. McCormick, 1922 city champion, and a galaxy of other tennis stars will be on hand to battle for the title.

Entries for the tournament should be phoned to Ralph Powell, Atlantic 0586, or the Omaha Field club, Harney 0240.

A charge of \$1.50 for singles, and \$2.50 for doubles will be made all entrants.

The Municipal Tennis Association, which is sponsoring the city meet, will also be sponsor of the municipal tournament for men, women and girls which will be held some time in August on the Field club courts.

For the first time in several years a tournament for the women of the city will be a possibility. Women racketeers of the city have had little opportunity to display their wares in late years, but this year they will have their chance.

Mr. Harman has the name and address of every tennis player in the city card indexed, and in this way expects to speed up the pairings in the tournaments.
