

Scattered Selling of Wheat Causes Slight Price Drop

Corn in Active Delivery Months Also Eases Up Under Light Selling Pressure.

By CHARLES J. LEYDEN, Universal Service Staff Correspondent. Chicago, June 28.—Improved weather conditions over the American and Canadian northwest led to scattered selling of the wheat pit today, largely in the form of a few contracts.

Weather conditions over the corn belt are such that unless conditions improve soon a short crop will result. Commission houses were operating moderately on the buying side, but the support was not sufficient to offset the steady selling in the way of profit taking, except in the December delivery.

The feature of the oats trade was the lack of selling pressure, except on the big lots. On the weak spots, support was timely. The oat market was fairly liberal, while in Canada precipitation was less extensive.
