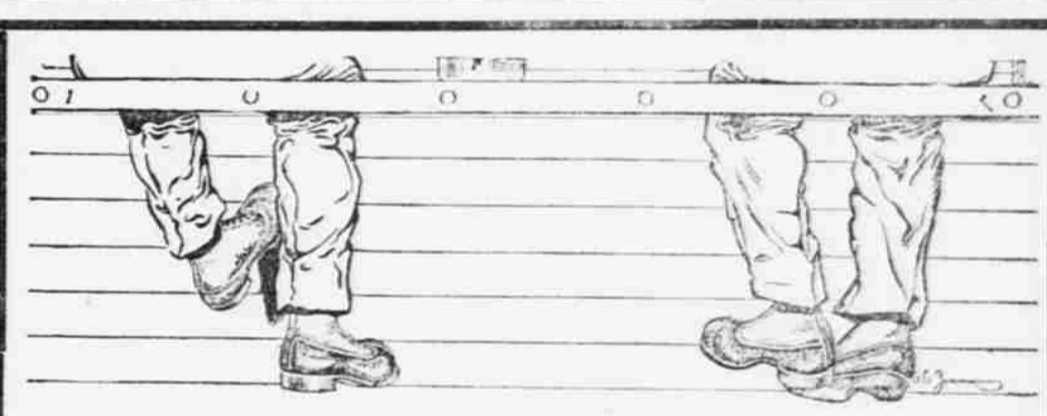
The Blue Front livery barn has been repurchased by Steve Wilson. Mr. Peterka, the late proprietor, will remain in the employ of Mr. Wilson.
