The ginger tea for a cold is used after this fashion: Put a teaspooful of sugar, and perhaps a teaspooniul of ground ginger in a cup, mix well and pour over it boiling water till the cup is little more than half full. When the sugar is dissolved strain it into a tumbler which should be a little more than half full, and then fill the glass with milk.

If this tea is taken immediately use cold milk, but if it must stand a while the milk must be heated, for the tea must be taken as hot as possible and while the feet are in hot water. This will induce prespiration, which will help greatly to check the cold. The patient should be put to bed at once, after thoroughly drying the feet .- New York Journal.
