The democratic delegates to the Chicago convention got together at the close of the convention and sent a telegraphic address to the democratic voters of Colorado stating that Cleveland is an enemy of free coinage, and that the platform gives no assurance that silver will be remonetized. The address closes with the following words:

"As between Cleveland and Harrison there can be no choice to free coinage men. Their records show them to be enemies to the cause so dear to Colorado hearts, and unless free coinage can be cast aside as of secondary importance to the country's welfare, the plain question is presented to both the democratic and republican voters, can they honestly, with a full sense of their obligation to self, home state and party, aid either of them for the presidency?"
