Sealed bids will be received at the office of the Department of Roads and Irrigation in the State House at Lincoln, Nebraska, on March 26, 1936, until 10:00 o'clock A. M., and at that time publicly opened and read for GRADING, SAND GRAVEL SURFACING, CULVERTS and incidental work on the AMELIA WEST U. S. WORKS PROGRAM HIGHWAY PROJECT NO. WPSO-422 FEDERAL AID ROAD.

The proposed work consists of constructing 2.6 miles of GRAVELLED Road. The approximate quantities are: 24,700 Cu. Yds. Excavation, 8,740 Cu. Yds. Top soil or Sand Clay Blanket Course, 19,310 Cu. Yd. Mi. Hauling Top Soil or Sand Clay Blanket Course Material, 1,354 Cu. Yds. Sand Gravel Surface Course Material, 100 Lin. Ft. 24-in. Culvert Pipe.

The contractor in the execution of the work under the contract for the grading and culvert items in accordance with the provisions of the specifications and the special provisions to the specifications shall provide a total of not less than 6,967 man hours of employment to persons directly employed on the contract secured from the designated Employment Agency or certified for assignment to the work by such agency.

The contractor in the execution of the work under the contract for the gravel surfacing items in accordance with the provisions of the specifications and the special provisions to the specifications shall provide a total of not less than 1,241 man hours of employment to persons directly employed on the contract secured from the designated Employment Agency or certified for assignment to the work by such agency.

The attention of bidders is directed to the Special Provisions covering subletting or assigning the contract and to the use of Domestic Materials.

The minimum wage paid to all skilled labor employed on this contract shall be fifty (50) cents per hour.

The minimum wage paid to all intermediate labor employed on this contract shall be forty (40) cents per hour.

The minimum wage paid to all unskilled labor employed on this contract shall be thirty (30) cents per hour.

The attention of bidders is also directed to the fact that the State Director of Reemployment, Lincoln, Nebraska, will exercise general supervision over the preparation of employment lists for this work, and subcontractors will be bound by the regulations effective January 15, 1935, jointly promulgated by the Secretary of the Treasury and the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to the provisions of Public Act No. 324, 73rd Congress, approved June 13, 1934 (48 Stat. 948), entitled, "An Act to effectuate the purpose of certain statutes concerning rates of pay for labor, by making it unlawful to prevent any one from re-

ceiving the compensation contract- ed for thereunder, and for other purposes."

Plans and specifications for the work may be seen and information secured at the office of the County Clerk at O'Neill, Nebraska, at the office of the District Engineer of the Department of Roads and Irrigation at Ainsworth, Nebraska, or at the office of the Department of Roads and Irrigation at Lincoln, Nebraska.
