

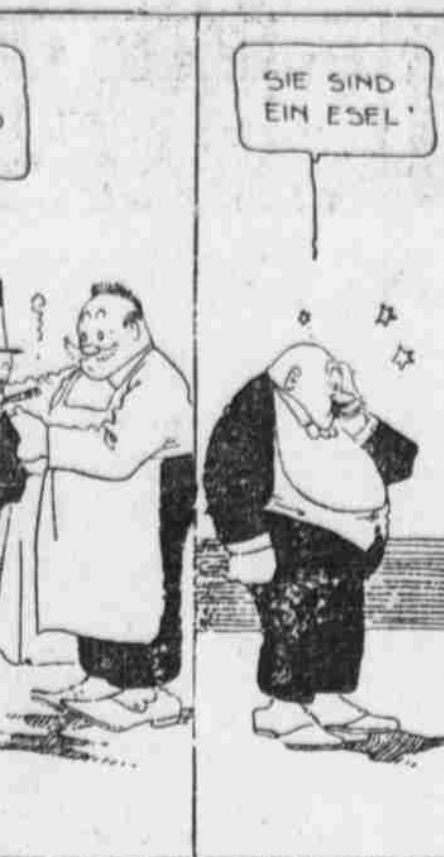

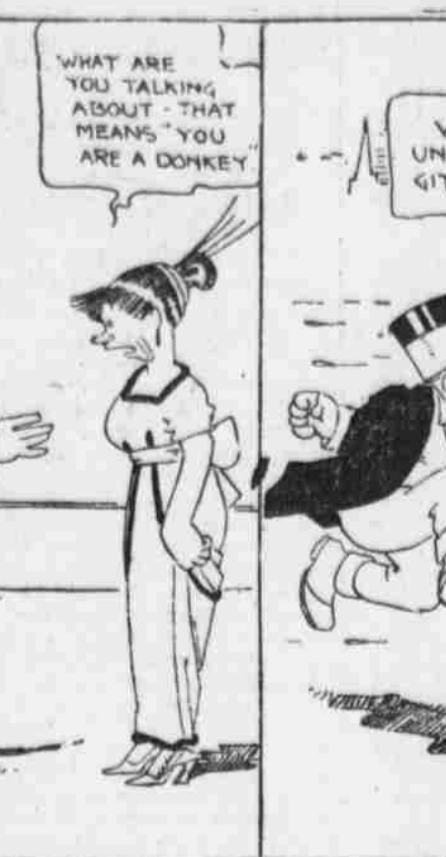

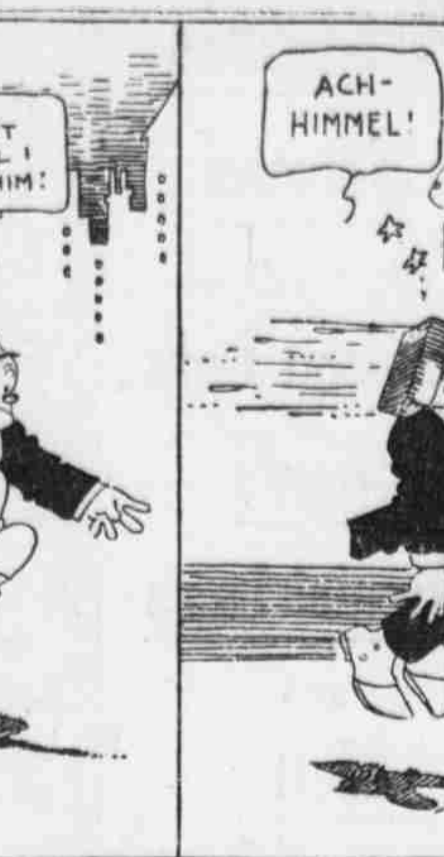

Johnson and Moran Matched for Title Contest in June

PARIS, Jan. 15.—"Jack" Johnson, the negro heavyweight pugilist, and Frank Moran, the Irishman heavyweight, today signed articles for a twenty-round bout for the championship of the world, to be fought on the day or before the Paris Grand Prix race, during the first or second week of June, this year.

Johnson was handed a check for \$55,000 by Charles McCarthy, representing a group of American sporting men, while Moran was guaranteed \$5,000. The fight is to take place in Paris.

The articles were signed in the Pavillon Dauphine in the Bois de Boulogne. There was a long discussion of the terms. Johnson raised numerous objections, one of which was his demand to be paid interest on the amount of the check, which is not payable until the day of the fight.

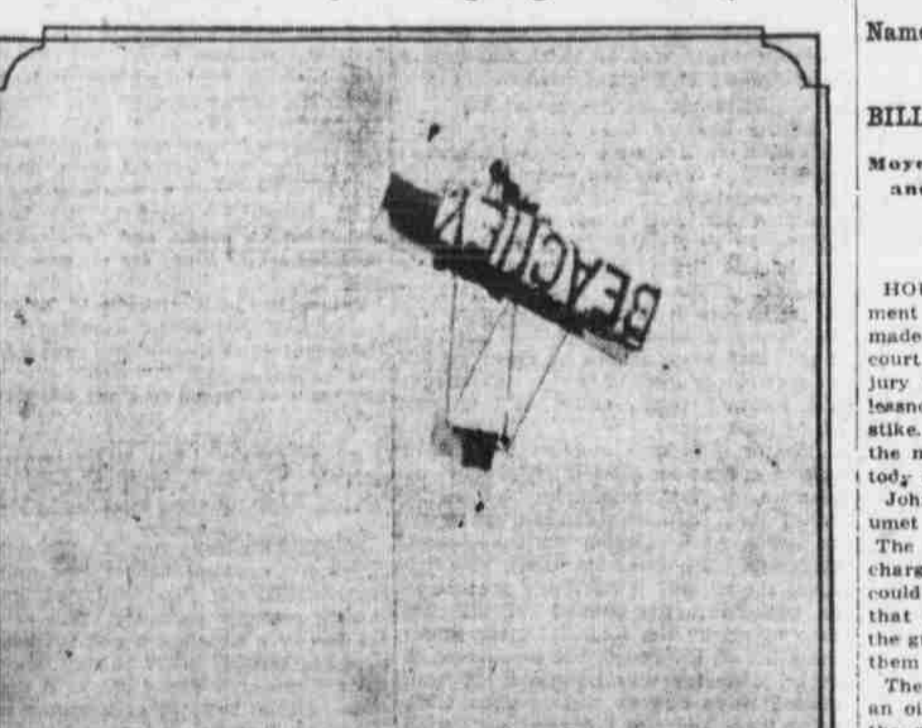
