Schiller camp, No. 394, give a prize week last Saturday night, February 14, at the German home.

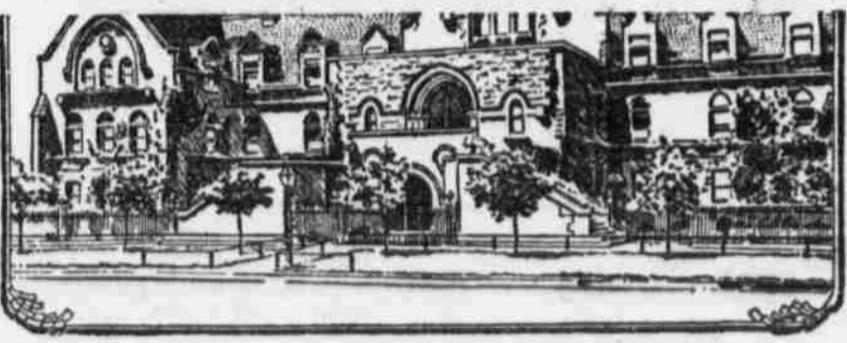
March 21, camp No. 321, meets at Twenty-second and Tenth streets, Wednesday evening, January 21.

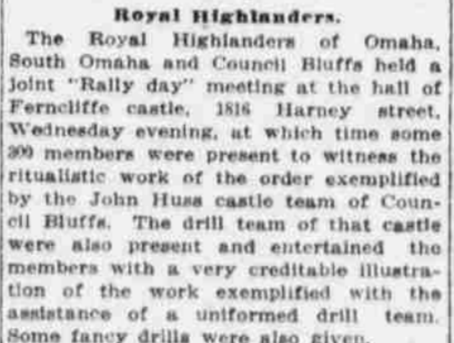
