**DIRECTOR OF CONCESSIONS AT PANAMA EXPOSITION.**



**Spends Large Sum For Its New Train**

With a view of affording visitors to the California expositions next year superior travel accommodations, the Union Pacific inaugurated nearly a year ago the Overland Limited extra fare train for the accommodation of people who demand the best in railway travel as well as in other things.

The Overland Limited was not put into service this far in advance of the exposition year as an experiment, but for the purpose of acquainting the traveling public with the service unknown previous to its inauguration. It is an all new train with all steel equipment, constructed along distinctive lines that embody every convenience heretofore known to modern rail travel, and a number of features never before offered.

The Union Pacific, in order to give its patrons superior service, was willing to make an expenditure of nearly \$5,000,000 for the building of the equipment for this new train.

**Exposition Notes.**  
 will be seen by the hundreds of thousands of night visitors to the Panama-Pacific International exposition when the great dome of the Palace of Horticulture is illuminated under the direction of W. O. Ryan, illuminating engineer, whose reputation extends all over the world.

Many of the most important and heaviest tasks in the preparation of the exposition have been completed. Such are the installation of the water, drainage, and electric conduit systems; the construction of seawalks, wharves and freight ferry slip, of the standard gauge terminal railroad system and other necessities.

The replica of the Yellowstone National park, which is to be constructed and operated by the Union Pacific railroad during the Panama-Pacific exposition, will not rob the park of any of its natural scenery, and after viewing this reproduction of the Yellowstone it will be possible for visitors having a little time to spare to visit this greatest of America's attractions as a side trip from either Ogden or Salt Lake City upon the return trip.

This side trip is not expensive and is an experience which can never be forgotten. The time consumed ranges in length from two days to six days on regular tours and may be lengthened to suit the convenience of the tourist. Tours may be arranged by either the stage and hotel route, or stage and permanent camps, both of which have their special features.

**SHEEP-SHEARING CONTEST PLANNED FOR PANAMA EXPO**

An international sheep shearing contest is planned as one of the interesting features of the Panama-Pacific exposition. The contest will be one of skill and speed between hand and machine shearing and will bring together sheep herders and flock masters from all quarters of the globe. Big prizes will be offered. An Idaho barber has made the first entry. He holds the record in Idaho, having shaved sixty long beards in a single day.

**Dramatic and Music Features Attract to Panama Exposition**

Although a little more than a year in advance of the opening of the exposition's gates is deemed too early to announce in full its dramatic, music and special events of purely entertainment features, George W. Stewart, chief of the department of music; Theodore Hardee, chief of the department of liberal arts, and Frank Burt, director general of concessions and admissions, announce such an extensive array of attractions as will stagger the imagination to conceive.

In the department of concessions there have been in the neighborhood of 7,000 applicants for space. This wealth of offers has rendered possible a splendidly selective choice, the magnitude and interest of which may be indicated from Frederic Thompson's concession, "Toyland Grown Up," which will cover twelve acres of the concession space and will cost over \$1,000,000.
