News from Southwest Says Wheat is Deteriorating.

MARKET IS NOT ENCOURAGING

Cash Grain is Not in Very Good Light—Corns Closes Somewhat Lower, with Lack of Immediate Demand.

As predicted for some time ago, a change in the southwestern wheat promise will be for the worse, and the first messages from that section making claims of deterioration were received here yesterday.

These claims were not in the nature of a time when wheat was at the lowest of the season near the close. Some of those who had sold wheat last year and will be seen on the buying side, which caused reactions of 1/4c and 1/2c.

The cash situation is anything but encouraging to holders of that grain. Sales are few, and buyers are not buying more than one-half of this week's crop.

Cash wheat was unchanged to 1/4c higher. Corn closed about 1/4c lower for May and 1/2c lower for July.

Chicago Grain and Provisions. Liquidation of hog receipts was popular yesterday and prices closed lower.

Primary oat receipts were 52,000 bu. and shipments 60,000 bu., against receipts of 1,415,000 bu. and shipments of 7,700 bu. last year.
