

Nebraska COURT HOUSE TAX LAW VOID

Act Providing for Bond Levy by Petition Declared Invalid. CASE COMES FROM BURT COUNTY

Lincoln, Neb., Feb. 27.—(Special Telegram.)—The supreme court today declared unconstitutional an act passed by the last legislature providing that upon a petition of 51 per cent of the voters a county board can make a levy for the building of a court house.

Insurance for Bartender. In an appeal from a judgment secured by Emma Kreeck against the supreme lodge of the Fraternal Union of America in the Douglas county district court the supreme court reversed the lower court in an opinion written by Justice Fawcett.

Section Men Must Look Out. A judgment of the district court of Douglas county is reversed in a case brought by Johanna M. Anderson against the Missouri Pacific railway for the death of her husband, a section foreman for the company.

Assumes Own Risk. The supreme court affirms the action of the Douglas county district court, which held that the administrator of the estate of John Cuba was not entitled to damages from the Cudahy Packing company of South Omaha, because of the death of the deceased, which occurred in the plant of the latter.

This Judgment Stands. The decision of the district court of Douglas county is affirmed in a judgment secured by Susan Inglehart against the Omaha & Council Bluffs Street Railway company for injuries received while alighting from a car at Fortieth and Hamilton streets.

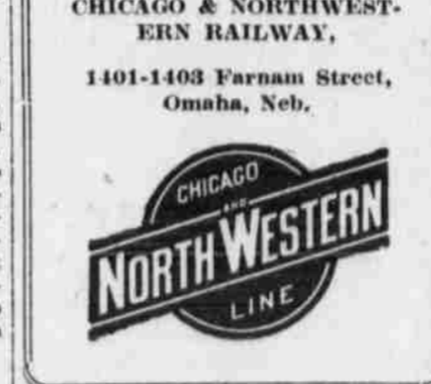
