**Crop Report is Not Sufficient to Start Stocks to Moving During the Season of Exchange.**  
**NEW YORK, June 8.—Favoring news** from several sources today elicited only a small response from the stock market. After the first half hour the tone was good, but operators were indifferent to outside influence and the market plodded along at a slow rate.  
 In a few cases there were few movements of some proportions, but the average movement was slight.  
 The greatest activity came in the first hour, indications of a possible rupture of the market proceeded with Mexico causing traders to put out a stock at the opening.  
 The supreme crisis of the day has long been awaited as a matter of first importance, failed to produce a ripple in the market. The report that the government would regulate interstate railroad rates, where such action is necessary to preserve interstate relations and that it is essential for the roads to have one master instead of as many masters as there are states, was all that had been hoped for in the financial district.  
 The crop report, also favorable, but likewise failed to stir the market. In fact prices slipped off a trifle in the last half hour.  
 The copper producers' report, showing an increase of 1,000,000 more gold for export also had no effect, owing to the large supplies of idle funds on hand here and the strong bank statement of Saturday.
