DELAY CONTAGION REPORTS

Dr. Connell Says He Will Prosecute Failure to Report.

COMPLAINTS HAVE BEEN MADE

One Child Dies of Diphtheria Before Quarantine is Made—Another Case Was a Week in Being Quarantined.

Delay in quarantining cases of contagious diseases has caused complaint to be made to the city health department. The health department puts the blame largely on physicians who fail to make report at once of contagion, it is alleged. Health Commissioner R. W. Connell has several times sent circular letters to all physicians in the city urging them to be more careful in preparing reports of contagious diseases and to use greater dispatch. This delay caused the health commissioner this year to notify physicians that unreasonable delays would result in prosecutions. One complaint made to the health department says the child suffering from diphtheria was dead before the quarantine was made. Another says it was one week after the child was known to have diphtheria before the place was quarantined. The health department is investigating these complaints. When cases of contagious diseases are reported to the health department culture are taken and examined and reports from these cultures are received the same day or early the day following.

Winnebago Indians on Way to Harvest

A party of fifteen Omaha and Winnebago Indians from the reservation in the vicinity of Fender arrived at the Union station waiting for a train to take them south that they might reach the Kansas wheat fields.

John Hawk, spokesman for the party of Indians, on harvesting bent, asserted that they would travel until they found wheat ready for cutting, that then they would drop off the train and in the fields, commence working their way back home. He anticipated that they would not in a month or more of time at from \$2.50 to \$3.00 per day.

Customs Men Have Tedious Job When Judging Clothes

Did you ever count the threads in a square inch of cloth? That task falls almost daily to the lot of men in the office of collector of customs here in the administration of the very complicated tariff governing cotton cloths, the most frequent article imported being curtains and tapestries.

For instance, if a sample of cloth containing fifty-one threads per square inch weighs more than 29.90 grains per 16 square inches, the average number of the yarn composing the sample is less than No. 3. If the sample is lighter and weighs from 29 to 29 grains, the average number of the yarn is between 3 and 19. Whenever the weight found is within 4 per cent of its given equivalent weight, it will be necessary to make further trials of at least four samples, and if the weight is again found to be within 4 per cent the sample must be conditioned, i. e. dried to some dryness and again added back. Perfectly simple, isn't it?
