

MEAT PRICES ARE SOARING

Porterhouse Steaks Now Cost 35 Cents Per Pound.

CANTALOUPE ARE SCARCE

Waxbeans Are Cheap and Abundant, as Are Also Cucumbers—Home Grown Tomatoes Are Also on the Market.

Meats have made another substantial advance in price during the last week.

Porterhouse steaks that cost him 30 cents a week ago, are now costing him 35 cents.

Round steaks that cost 25 cents, are costing 30 cents. There is a big demand for round steak.

In the wholesale market beef has jumped 71 per cent and that is why the retail prices have followed.

Pork that was wholesaling a week ago at 12 cents, now costs 17 cents.

Lamb is 30 cents a hundred higher than a week ago, and is still scarce.

Smoked meats are advancing in the wholesale market about \$1 a week.

Much nice fruit is still on the market, although apples are scarce and still a nickel a pound.

Clear red jelly plums are on the market at 35 cents a basket.

Salmon-cut cherries are of good quality and selling at 10 cents a quart.

Cantaloupes Are Scarce. Cantaloupes have made a big bound.

Wax beans are cheap and abundant. While they were selling for 30 cents a basket when they first came on the market.

Denver cauliflower is here at 10 cents a pound.

Home grown ripe tomatoes are selling at 75 cents a pound.
