Cornhuskers Emerge from Kansas Game Without Injury.

SCRIMMAGE WORK FIRST DAY

Interference Was Never Better Than at Lawrence and Mad Alone Prevented Running Bigger Score.

LINCOLN, Nov. 17 .- (Special.)-Coach Stiehm and the victorious Husker eleven today began preparations for the final game of the season with the dangerous Hawkeyes, whose 65 to 7 defeat of Ames last Saturday has thrown terror in the hearts of the Nebraskans.

While the mud at Kansas prevented Nebraska from piling up a much larger score against the Jayhawkers, it was the salvation of the crippled Nebraska squad, for with the exception of Towle, the entire team came out of the game in practically as good shape as they entered. Towle was bruised, but his injuries are not at all serious.

Fully appreciating the high scores which lown has piled up in the last three games, the Huskers are not greatly alarmed at the fast Iowa backfield. Iowa has not been up against a pair of first class tackles in the last three games and it is believed that McGinnis and his men will find an entirely different proposition from any of the games they have played in this season.



BERLIN, Nov. 17 .- King Ferdinand Bulgaria, who arrived today in Coburis passing through such a crists, according to well informed circles in Coburg and Berlin that his abdication of the throne in favor of his son is possible and even probable.

The king is residing incognito at the palace in Coburg.

He spent this morning in prayer at the graves of his ancestors.

Austrian statesmen are doing their utmost to discourage his proposed surrender of the throne because they consider the young crown prince. Boris, likely to be influenced by the element friendly to

King Ferdinand, at the same time, is receiving little encouragement in Germany. Emperor William and the German government have expressed themselves openly as friendly to Greece. It is understood that when King Ferdinand expressed a desire to come to Berlin he was given an intimation that such a visit would be uneless

Ferdinand is the youngest son of the late Prince Augustus of Saxe-Coburg-Gotha and was elected prince of Bulgaria on July 7, 1887. He declared himself. king in 1908 and was recognized by the powers. The Bulgarian legation here has issued a denial of the reports that he intends to quit the throne, but the denial is regarded here as merely perfunctory.


