At this time Chieago is getting the credit for all of the wheat handled in from Omaha and such points as Konsas City, thus swelling the daily receipts and hogsting it without any warrant. If the member has deposited Il a week for that time, the bank puts in to complete 150 for the depositor, If he has put in \$2 n week for forty-eight weeks th bank puts in \$4 for him to round out

Those who put in \$3 a week will reeive a bonus of M. Those, who for any reason are unable to keep up their weekly deposits, will lose nothing, as they may draw out their money at any time. No person may have more than one account, although the various members of any family can each have an individual


