DEGRIES THE FORWARD PASS

Crimson Coach Discredits Theory It Is Effective in Offense.

CONSERVATIVE GAME IS BEST

Declares Harvard Was Handed Last Year's Contest with Yale, But Won That Played This Fall.

CAMBRIDGE, Mass., Dec. 17.—"Harvard was handed last year's game with Yale, but won that played this fall," declared Percy D. Haughton, head coach of the Crimson team, said tonight at a students' mass meeting in honor of Harvard's championship eleven.

Haughton pointed out in pictures thrown on a screen seven " glaring mistakes" which he said were made by the Yale team in the 1912 game with Harvard. Harvard played errorless football in this year's Yale game, he added, except for one offside play. No reference was made to the play by which O'Brien of Harvard unwittingly scored a safety for Yale.

Haughton discredited the theory that the forward pass is an effective weapon

of offense, and exhibited charts to support his point. He insisted that the forward pass is of little value when the opponents know how to cope with it. The conservative game, such as that played by Harvard teams in recent years, he said, is the best practical theory of offense.

Coach Haughton referred frequently to Captain Ketcham of Yale. He showed several pictures of plays in the stadium in which Ketcham figured, pointed out that in each Ketcham was smothered by the Harvard forwards, while the play was carried through. This was the reason, Haughton declared, that Ketcham was not chosen for the "All-American" team by Walter Camp. Ketcham's roughness during the early part of the Harvard game gave the Crimson an early advantage, said the coach.

Harvard players will elect their captain for next year tomorrow.

EBBETTS SAYS STANDING PAT ON THE TINKER DEAL

NEW YORK, Dec. 17.—Charles H. Ebbetts, president of the Brooklyn club, said today that he would reply to the message received yesterday from the Cincinnati club directors seeking to cancel the sale of Joe Tinker to the Brooklyn for \$25,000.

"I shall say in substance," said Ebbetts, "what I have already said—that the deal was made in good faith and that we stand pat. For me to consider any other suggestions to acquiring Tinker would be tacit admission that I consider the present agreement not binding."

"I am satisfied we can make satisfactory arrangements with Tinker when the time comes. The Brooklyn club would not accept \$25,000 cash for him this minute. The action of the Cincinnati club is entirely without precedent. Only the highest tribunal of base ball could take him away from us."
