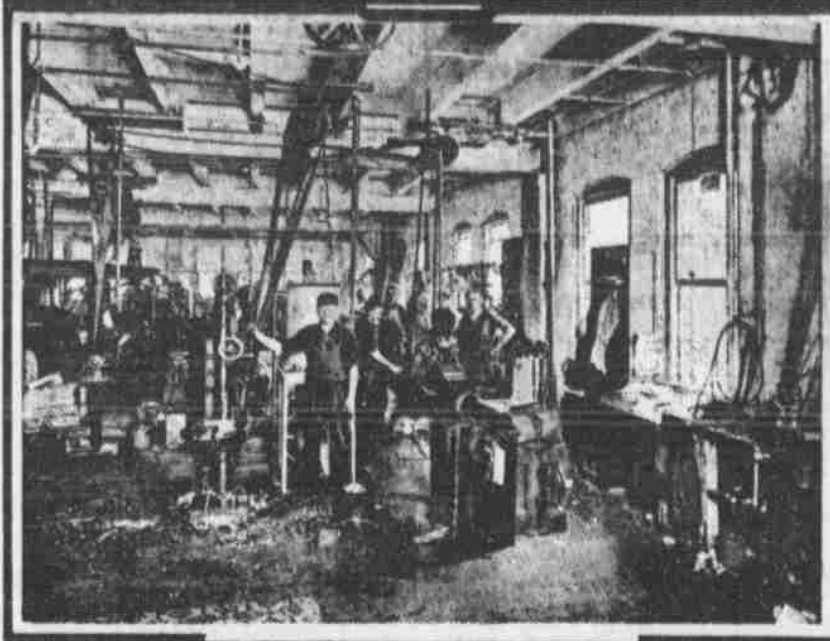

New Complete Plant of the Drummond Motor Company



The erection of the magnificent and modern garage by the Drummond Motor company, at Twenty-sixth and Farnam streets, marked an epoch in the local automobile industry and was an incentive for other motor companies to seek new quarters in the West Farnam street district.

Drummond's building stands out as one of the most up-to-date automobile houses in this section of the country. Much money and time was spent in its erection and the result is the garage is complete in the most minute detail.

The building has seventy-five feet frontage on Farnam street and extends 142 feet back on Twenty-sixth street, and is three stories high. The basement is used as a store room and garage proper. Freight and cars are taken into and out of the basement on a large elevator capable of carrying tons of freight. Entrance

is gained on the elevator through a side door drive. Hundreds of Omaha motorists house their machines in the garage.

The first floor is occupied by the offices, show rooms and a garage in the rear. The show rooms are elaborately decorated, large plate glass windows around the front and side of the building, showing the cars off to great advantage. The repair work is done on the second floor.

The workmen employed in this department make everything from a baby carriage to the largest make of machine, and are able to repair anything on four wheels. Bodies, tops and other necessities are built in the repair department.

The paint shop is situated on the top floor. The company is now swamped with orders for repairing and decorating cars and the men employed in these departments are kept on the job day and night taking care of the many orders.

CIVIL WAR VETERANS HAVE FIRST RIDE IN AUTOMOBILE

No one ever enjoyed the luxurious Pathfinder "W" more than a party of Grand Army of the Republic veterans, members of the Battery F, First Ohio light artillery, who were whisked through the beautiful residence district of Indianapolis and out to the speedway during the twenty-fifth annual convention in the Hoosier capital.

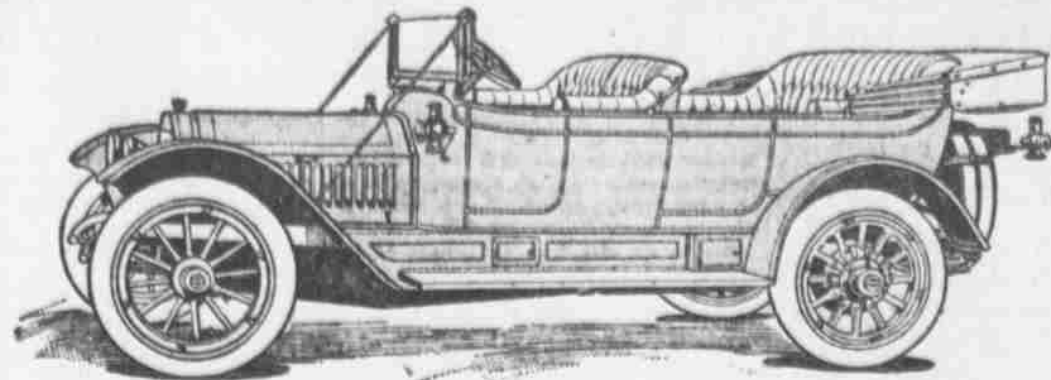
Biggest One-Floor Garage.

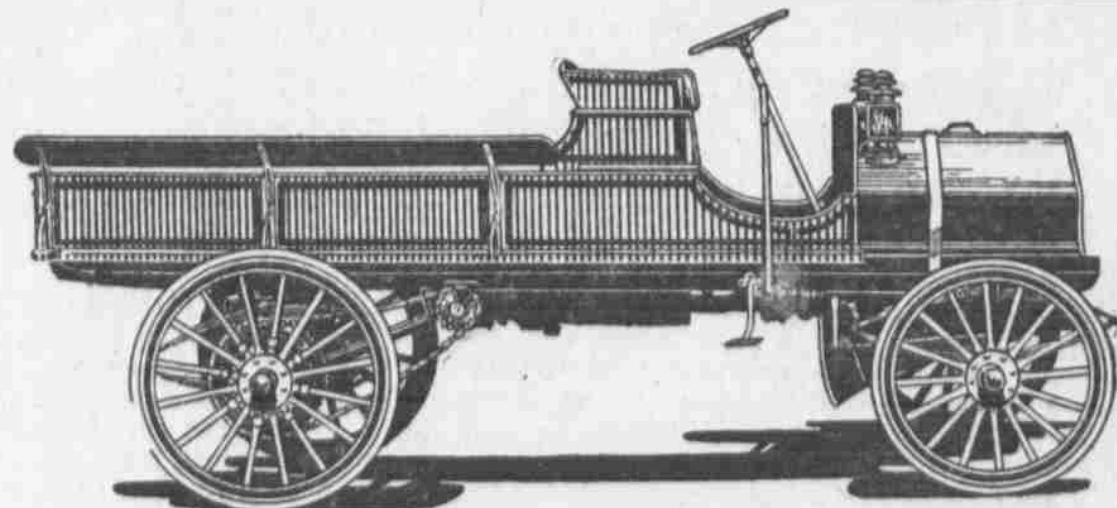
