J. F. Weitzell Dies at His Old Home

Word has been received in Omaha of the death of J. F. Weitzell at his old home in Logan, O., where he passed away Monday morning after a lingering illness, aged about 82 years.

Mr. Weitzell had been employed by the Illinois Central Railroad company over twenty-five years, having entered the general offices as a clerk. To him promotions came rapidly. He occupied the position of chief clerk in the general offices at Louisville, Ky.; Memphis, Tenn., and New Orleans. Then he was promoted to division freight agent at Evansville, Ind., which position he held at the time he was sent to Omaha as assistant general freight agent. He came to this city in December, 1908, when the Illinois Central built into Omaha from Port Dodge, Ia., and opened headquarters here.

Remains in Omaha until May 1, 1913, Mr. Weitzell was transferred to St. Louis as assistant general freight agent there. This position he held at the time of his death. His health began to fail early this year, and February 1 he was given a leave of absence of one year, retaining his position and title.

NEW RECORD FOR LATE REPORTING OF BIRTHS
