DES MOINES, Ia., June 10.—(Special.)—It is going to be put right up to President Woodrow Wilson and the Interstate Commerce Commission to provide in some way through federal aid for the protection of the interests of the American consumers in the matter of the forthcoming valuation of the railroads by a commission of engineers and experts.

More Normal High Schools.

It is expected the decision of the supreme court in which it was held that the law is unconstitutional that undertakes to give to a police officer the right to summarily dispose of a domestic animal found to be unfit for use, will seriously affect the work of various humane societies in the state.

State Officials' Rights.

BUMPER WHEAT CROP SEEN

Record Harvest of 1901 May Be Reached This Year.

BARLEY ACREAGE DECREASED

Total Production of Oats Will Be Nearly Four Hundred Million Bushels Less Than That of Last Year.

WASHINGTON, June 10.—A bumper wheat crop, sufficient to mill more than 15,000,000 barrels of flour and which will reach the proportions of the record wheat harvest of 1901, if conditions from now on are exceptionally favorable, was forecast today by the Department of Agriculture in its June crop report.

Government experts estimated this year's harvest would be 74,000,000 bushels, of which 62,000,000 bushels will be winter wheat—a record for this crop—and 32,000,000 bushels will be spring wheat.
