Leading Issues and Specialties Score Advance of One to Five. HIGHER PRICES FOR COPPER. Wall Street Not Worried Over Spread of Strike in Michigan.

NEW YORK, July 25.—What promises to be the most comprehensive movement in the stock market since the abnormal dullness of the early summer was witnessed today.

The rise followed four consecutive days of more or less steady advance. Factors that contributed to the market's improvement included higher prices for copper.

The general bond market was strong for the greater part of the session, but some of the government issues were again prominent.
