Cosson Argues on Constitutionality of Vasectomy Law

REOKUK, In., April 15-Arguments on the constitutionality of the lowa law, imposing the operation of vanectomy on prisoners in lows penitentiaries twice convicted of a felony, were presented today to Circuit Judge Walter J. Smith, Judge John C. Pollock of Kansas and Judge Smith Henderson of Iowa, sitting in the federal court.

Although admitting that the law did not apply to any prisoner now in Iowa prisons, and advising the court that the lowa Board of Phrole had rescinded its order of sterilization, Attorney General Coston in his arguments asserted he had no objection to an injunction being issued against the Board of Parole and the warden and physician of the Fort Madison prison to prevent them from performing vasectomy on the complainants, but he did want a decision upon the constitutionality of the act.

Atturney George B. Stewart, representing twenty-three convicts in the Fort Madison prison, insisted that an injunction should be issued.

## 'Mutiny" in Coxey Army; Mule Hauling the Chieftain Balks

LOUISVILLE, O., April 18 .- The first act of insubordination in the "army of unemployed" which "General" Jacob S. Coxey of Massillon, O., is leading to Washington developed today while the "army" was on its way here from Canton. The dignified mule that draws the phacton in which Coxcy rides balked at crossing a mud puddle in the road. Only after the "general's" courier, David Coxey, 11 years of age, had driven his pony through the puddle would the mule proceed. Thereafter it was necessary for David to lead the way.

When the "army" arrived here this afternoon its forces had been swelled, and a total of thirty "privates" were in line. Tonight the marchers slept in the town hall at the invitation of Mayor Coy.
