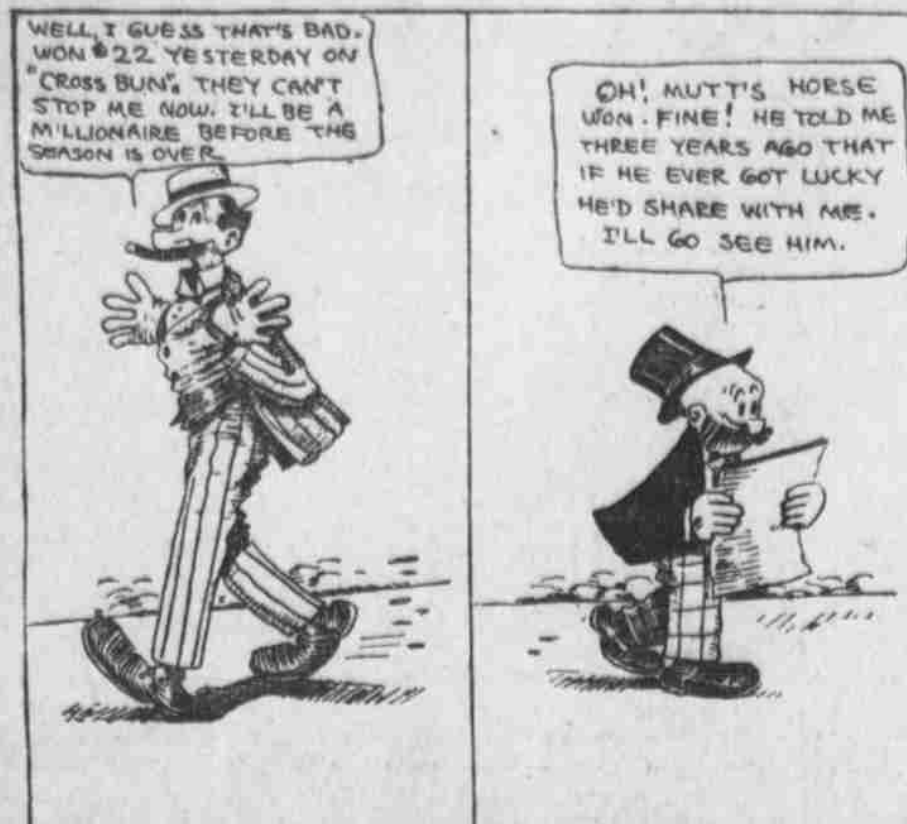

PULPIT ORATOR STUDIED GREEK AS PLOWED CORN

Dr. Newell Dwight Hillis, successor of Henry Ward Beecher and Dr. Lyman Abbott in the pulpit of the Brooklyn Tabernacle, and one of the noted pulpits of the world, is the guest of Dr. and Mrs. A. P. Hanchett of Council Bluffs. Dr. Hillis is accompanied by his daughter, who has been traveling with him while he is filling some of his lecture engagements.

Dr. Hillis spent his young manhood working on a farm in Harrison county, Iowa. He tells a story of his experiences on the farm and the unfavorable impression he created upon neighboring farmers, especially during the last summer of his work.

While plowing corn with a "double-shovel" plow, he conceived the scheme of rigging up a book rack between the handles of the plow and worked it out with greatest success. As he walked behind the plow he could easily keep his eyes fixed on his book and study to good advantage. The neighboring rustics chaffed him a good deal, but he did not mind it. Referring to it in later years Dr. Hillis said:

"I guess I didn't raise a very good corn crop that year, but I had a fine crop of Greek."

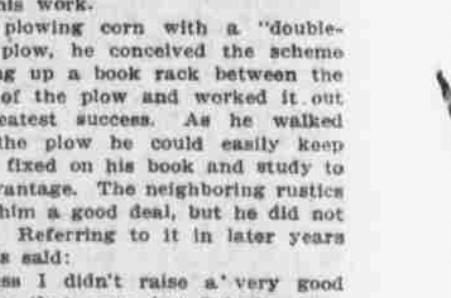
