Responsibility of Averting It Put Up to Small Farmers.

PACKERS BECOMING ALARMED

All Agree if Decrease in Production in Last Decade Not Stopped

Question of Supply Most Serious.

CHICAGO, Sept. 23.—The responsibility of averting a future meat famine was put up to small farmers today by speakers at the eighth annual convention of the American Meat Packers' convention here.

The remaining ranges should be put up in farms to put all farmers on an equal footing.
