

REALTY MEN GO ON WARPATH

Give Vent to Pent Up Feelings Against City Hall Crowd.

OPPOSE THE GAS COMPROMISE

Object to Raising Salary of Secretary of Board of Education—Also Object to Autos for City Officials.

Certain members of the Omaha Real Estate exchange virtually turned the city hall upside down yesterday and stepped on the necks of every official within it. W. H. Green and W. T. Graham, wearing their togas they spent the week in buckling on, came to the weekly meeting, bellicose and talkative, and led in the upturning of scandal at eighteenth and Farnam streets.

The proposed compromise between the city and gas company to secure dollar gas and the recent raise in salary of the secretary of the Board of Education were the principal targets for these more belligerent members of the exchange.

It used to be that a stenographer was enough, but now they must each have an attorney and then the city must have an attorney to act over the other attorneys. We have a corporation attorney now.

"There are enough politicians and city employes now," he went on, "to take care of the affairs of two states the size of Nebraska. Take this idea of a Water board attorney—I don't know whether he's getting \$5,000 or \$15,000 a year—whatever he wants, I suppose. I can remember when John L. Webster was getting \$600 a year and tickled to get it running around electroneering to get it."

Ideas on Planning. Green also took the occasion to express his opinions about Mayor Dahlman's city planning idea and the Civic League. He said about all the city planning ideas of the mayor would amount to would be to bring experts here from the east, have them ride over the city in one of the city's automobiles, draw a few "pictures" and receive \$10,000. "That will be the last of it," he concluded. "We had better spend that money in getting cleaner streets or give it to the poor."

After the smoke had cleared away Alfred C. Kennedy of the Board of Education was noticed sitting in the room. He was called upon for a talk and in it defended the board's action in raising the secretary's salary. The secretary, he said, had to handle \$50,000 or \$60,000 a year and do all the work of the board. He thought \$5,000 a year was not too much for this service.
