TO CENTER ON TARIFF BILLS

Democrats Plan to Devote Extra Session to One Measure.

ASK WILSON TO APPROVE

Intention is to Center Attention of Public on the Bill After it Gets Into the Upper House.

WASHINGTON, March 6.—President Wilson was strongly urged by house leaders today to use his influence for and agree to a plan which would convene congress at the special session called for April 1.

The house leaders want to pass the tariff bills as quickly as possible, send them to the senate and then have the house adjourn for periods of three days at a time.

In the opinion of some house leaders this would enable President Wilson and the democrats in the senate, through their own power and the force of public attention to get such tariff legislation as the democratic platform declared to be necessary.

Democrats in the senate today resumed their caucus to determine on a plan of reorganization of the senate and reshaping of committees that are to have charge of legislation in the new congress.

Chairman Kern presented the following names of senators who are to compose the steering committee to make up democratic committee assignments and they were unanimously approved.
