# VEGETABLE PRICES STEADY Armed Negro Holds

Meat Prices Go Up One Cent, with Butter About the Same

SUGAR IS NOW SOME CHEAPER

Apples Are Plentiful, with Little Indieation that They Will Be Amy Cheaper During This Spring.

That dealers in foodstuffs are not being frightened by the high cost of living investigating committee might be attested from the fact that groceries are practically on the same scale of prices this vanced a cent.

The larger dealers in groceries are still contending that the small merchants in the outskirts of the city are responsible for the high prices, while those grocers are in turn pointing the accusing finger to the commission and produce men-

Butter and eggs are on the same level as a week ago, the best butter being sold by the larger grovery dealers at 37 cents a pound and by the smaller ones around 40 and 42 cents, while eggs are universally around the 20-cent mark. Butter on the Elgin market went up 4-cent, but local grocers say the effect will be slight on the retail price here.

Other commodities, such as sugar, coffee and flour, remain practically at the same figure. The larger dealers are retailing augar at twenty-two pounds for \$1, while the smaller ones are getting \$1 for eighteen pounds. Green coffee has declined % cent, but the benefit will come only to the roasters, who are said really to be the only great profit getters from

Vegetable Prices Hold.

Fruits and vegetables also are selling at figures which obtained a week ago. Grapefruit, which has come into such great demand within the last few weeks, has raised in price. The advance so far amounts to 25 cents a box and single fruits are selling at 5, 7%, 8% and 10 cents a piece. Remauranteurs realize the greatest profit on grapefruit, buying them at less than 5 cents each and selling them at 10 cents for a half of a small one, the customer having to pay 300 to 400 per cent for the work of cutting them in two and sprinking sugar on them. Apples are selling around 20 and 25 cents a full peck at the large groceries and 30 cents a dozen at the smaller stores. Albert King, manager of Hayden Bros.' grocery department says apples are plentiful, but will not become cheaper because the small grocers hold up the price and lessen the demand.

Eggplants are 10 cents each and cucumbers are 15 cents. Shallots, beets, carrots, turnips and radishes are selling three bunches for a dime. Cranberries sell' two quarts for 15 cents. Colery retails two stalks for a nickel. Cauliflower may be had at 7½ cents a head. Small grocers are getting 20 cents for it.


