

Superintendent of Red Cross Here to Supervise Work

E. T. Lies, Chicago district superintendent, of Washington, D. C., who is the national director of the Red Cross society in the United States, arrived in Omaha yesterday morning and will take charge of the Red Cross work in the city. He will be assisted a great deal by Miss Lillian Stoff, who is the Red Cross nurse at the dispensary of the Visiting Nurse association.

The nurses are doing field work at the present time and there will be a Red Cross nurse at each relief station after Wednesday. Owing to the fact that the telephone connections are hard to get many of the nurses enlisted in the Red Cross service in the city have not yet been reached.

At the dispensary of the Visiting Nurse association about fifty people have been given medical attention. Most of the injuries are the result of cuts from flying pieces of glass and the wounds have been neglected. Many of the victims as they come to the dispensary, which is in Jacobs hall, are also given food and clothing.

Dean Tancock, who has made a relief station of this building for the victims of the storm Sunday, has received both food

and clothing from the women of Trinity. Nearly every member of the parish has sent in a bundle of something and orders for food at the different groceries.

Miss Magee of the City mission is doing field work. She is taking bedding and clothes to those who are in the storm district and is helping to find houses for those who have lost their homes. She is being assisted by many of the young society women in her relief work.

OFFERS OF ASSISTANCE FROM OUTSIDE STILL COME
