

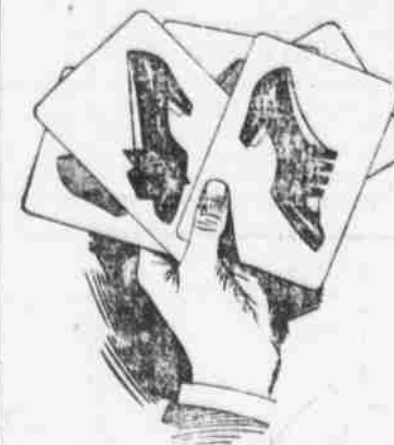

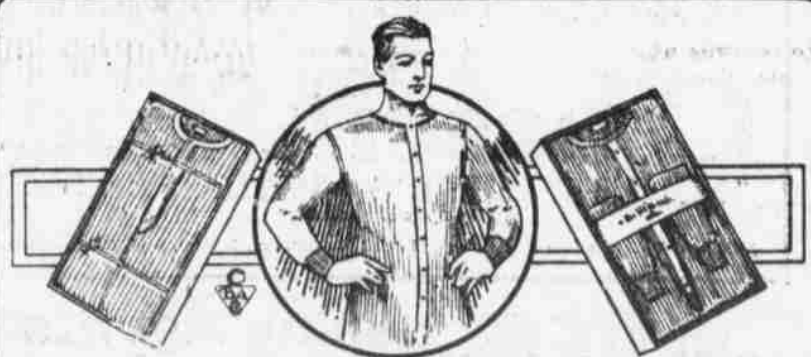

### NOT MUCH CHANGE IN OMAHA

Business Men Talk of New Law on Employment of Females.

NINE HOURS CONSTITUTE A DAY

In Past Generally Same Rule Was Applied and New Conditions Will Make Little Difference Here.

Department store managers and manufacturers generally in Omaha say that Senate File 294, providing for a nine-hour day for female labor will not affect them to any extent.

"We haven't been working our girls over nine hours, anyway, even under the ten-hour law," said Thomas F. Quinlan, manager of Hayden Bros' department store. "Even when the ten-hour law was in effect, as it still is, we have not been working the girls ten hours, and I believe the same is true of most department stores."

The general opinion is that the factories of the city have worked their girls less than ten hours per day in most cases, even when the ten-hour law was in effect, and that few large business establishments will be affected by the new law. The packing houses, it is

### JUDGES STOPPING DELAYS

New System in the District Court Facilitates the Work.

MORE CASES ARE NOW FILED

On the Other Hand, There Are Many More Settlements Made Out of Court by Litigants Than Ever Before.

The law's delay in Omaha courts is a thing of the past. The "stipulated system" of assigning cases for trial and the resolution taken by the judges of the district court a year ago last January to compel litigants to go to trial as soon as possible have brought about this result.

Judge Sutton of court room No. 1, who has charge of the district court docket, announced today, the last day of the February term, that he will give notice to attorneys that any case is subject to trial in the May term of court, which begins the first Monday in May. This is in contrast to conditions two years ago, when the judges were a year and one-half behind in their work.
