SUIT FOR FIFTEEN MILLIONS

Iowa County Will Ask Rock Island Road to Pay Back Taxes.

FAILURE TO LIST SECURITIES

Amount Sought So Great that Its Collection Might Embarrass Line and Hidden Meaning is Sought for Move.

Suit for approximately \$15,000,000 in back taxes will be brought against the Chicago, Rock Island & Pacific Railroad company by the supervisors of Polk county, Iowa.

It is asserted the Rock Island company has concealed \$100,000,000 in monies, credits and corporation shares and stocks during the last five years.

The Rock Island company's attorneys assert there is no foundation for the suit and that the taxes have been promptly paid.
